



PROTECT LOCAL SERVICES. **LIMIT CORPORATE POWER.**

Proposition 43 limits voters' ability to fund essential local services and gives even more power to corporations. Vote No on Prop 43 to protect your vote and keep the power where it belongs: with you and your neighbors.

PROP 43 MAKES IT HARDER TO FUND CRITICAL, LIFESAVING LOCAL SERVICES

- Communities around California are passing local measures to fund essential local services. Prop 43 lets a small minority block that funding, even when a clear majority of voters say Yes.
- Prop 43 attacks the ability voters' ability to support fire departments and fund wildfire prevention, fix local roads, staff our local schools or backfill federal health care cuts.

PROP 43 GIVES CORPORATIONS MORE POWER

- Corporations already have too much power in our elections. Prop 43 gives them even more. When voters try to pass local ballot measures to make corporations pay their fair share, the corporations would only need one-third of the vote to block it. With their campaign money and just one-third of the vote, corporations win forever.
- Prop 43 protects the powerful few at everyone else's expense.

VOTE NO ON PROP 43

- Firefighters, local police chiefs, teachers, nurses and affordable housing and environmental groups all oppose this measure because Prop 43 makes it harder to provide and protect our local communities. Vote No on Prop 43 to protect your vote and keep the power where it belongs: with you and your neighbors.
